

Call for Michigan Ceramic Artists

Event Date: Sept 19 – 20, 2020, Sat & Sun 10:00 – 5:00

<u>Deadline:</u> Application must be postmarked by <u>April 30, 2020</u> to be included in the printed publicity (brochures and save-the-date postcards). Fees must accompany the application.

About the Tour: This 4th year of the tour is a celebration of clay art, clay artists and the amazing studios where the work is created. The art includes both functional and sculptural work. It is a unique opportunity to sell your work in a private studio setting with other ceramic artists from around the state of Michigan. Ten rural ceramic studios, located from Bath to Williamston to Mason, have opened their studios for this tour and invite additional ceramic artists from the state to join them to sell and demonstrate their work. Perks for participating include additional exposure through various display opportunities, a beautiful and supportive show location, as well as a Saturday artist's dinner to encourage ceramic community and networking.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Artists must be juried and be from or living in Michigan. A minimum of 3 current images are required. Images should be on a neutral background and ready for publication. Each image *must* be labeled. (See instructions below on how to label images)

- Do not include other matters with this email, just images and a brief introduction.
- Please note: Returning artists do not need to be juried in. However, current images are encouraged for the brochures and other publications. <u>The full fee of \$85 is required</u>.

Fees: Two checks *must* accompany application. 1) Application Fee: \$25 (non-refundable) and 2) Booth fee of \$60. CHECKS SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO CPST. If not juried into the show, the booth fee check will be returned.

Instructions for labeling images:

When labeling the image, <u>at minimum include your name and title of the piece</u>. You may include other pertinent information. Make your title descriptive (red tea pot), not generic (pot). Do not label two images exactly the same.

Example: Fritz, Mary *Edwina* 60" x 28" terracotta 2019 PC or Android: Right click over image. Choose *rename*

Apple: Tap image with 2 fingers. Choose *rename* or highlight image and press enter then choose *rename*.
